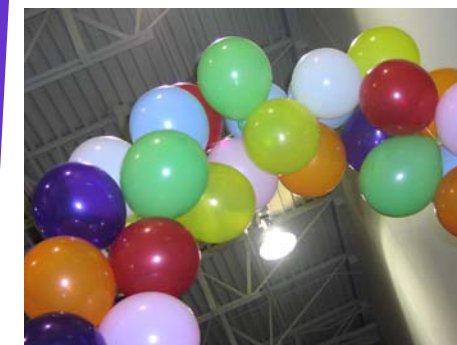

Children's Ministries



Children's Church is available each Sunday during the 8:30 and 11:00 am worship service. Children's Church is for children ages 4 through 1st grade. The children meet the Children's Church Coordinator in the back of the sanctuary immediately following the Children's Time.



Vacation Bible School is held each summer during the last week of June. We start each evening at 5:30 pm with a snack dinner followed by an evening of recreation, bible stories, crafts, music, missions, and fun activities centered around an exciting theme. VBS is for children 3 years old through the 5th grade. The 5th graders

are called our Mission Maniacs. The Mission Maniacs spend their week doing a different mission project each evening during VBS.

Sunday School classes are offered for all ages with classes for children age 3 through 5th grade, held in our education wing. We utilize age-specific, Bible-based curriculum in each of the classes and our teachers all share a love for the Lord and a desire to share that love with children. Each week, during the Gathering at 9:45 am, the children meet in the sanctuary where children welcome visitors, recognize birthdays, and sing praise songs. Their teachers then escort them to their class and parents pick-up children at their classroom at 10:45 am



Children's Choir

The Children's choirs combine to sing in worship services throughout the school year.

Children's Choir meets from 6:15 to 7:00 every Wednesday evening during the school year.



Mission Possible Kids is a hands-on missions program for kids in grades 1st through 5th. MPKids is about empowering kids to change the world. Children become "Special Agents" doing God's work. MPKids meets every Wednesday during the school year at 6:00pm.



GLOW Kids is a division of Mission Possible Kids for ages 3 through Kindergarten. "GLOW" stands for Go Love Others in the World. Children will learn how to GLOW for God from the inside out. GLOW Kids meets every Wednesday during the school year at 6:00pm.



Acolytes provide children a unique opportunity to begin serving our church during the Worship service. They perform a variety of tasks, all of which help them learn the meaning of worship including symbols and historic Christian tradition. Children in grades 3 – 5 are invited to train with the coordinator and serve in this meaningful Worship experience.



Professional child care is provided for church related activities. These include, but are not limited to, Sunday Worship,

Sunday School, Wednesday Night Wesley Meals, Music Rehearsals, daytime and evening Bible Study.

Special arrangements for child care services can be made for many other activities, including funerals and weddings.
